## **The Original Woman with a Mission**

Thanks to her shining example of ministering to the poor, Catherine McAuley received a surprise inheritance. With it, she founded the *Sisters of Mercy* in 1831. They became known as the “walking sisters” for their willingness to go out into the community where they were most needed. From the start, the mission of Mercy depended on people willing to give their time and resources to build the ministry.
