Jerra and Jeremy faced a six-year struggle with infertility before the joyous discovery that they were expecting. Despite a healthy start, Jerra developed severe pre-eclampsia at 26 weeks, leading to her hospital admission and an emergency C-section at 29 weeks. Baby Eleanor, born at just 2.5 pounds, was immediately taken to the NICU.

Jerra vividly recalls the compassionate care the NICU nurses provided, tending to all of Eleanor's needs as she grew stronger and healthier.
