# A Personal Journey and a Community's Strength

For the past 13 years, I've had the privilege of working alongside the exceptional team at Mercy Cancer Center as the experience manager. In April 2022, my life took an unexpected turn when I was diagnosed with cancer.

I was fortunate to have resources and a strong support system during my cancer journey. However, many of the thousands of patients we treat each year are not as fortunate. Increasingly, we see patients who struggle to afford the necessities of daily living. The funds generated

through the Cancer Care Fund are used to help real people with real needs right here in Southeast Missouri.

My journey began with a diagnosis of Microcystic Adnexal Carcinoma. Due to the complexity of this cancer, I was referred to St. Louis for tumor removal and ear reconstruction. After three surgeries, I returned home to Mercy Cancer Center, where I was treated by Dr. Joseph Miller, a specialist in radiation oncology. Dr. Miller candidly

discussed my best chances for a positive prognosis, given my high risk for recurrence.

I completed 30 radiation treatments on January 19, 2023. Although I was offered a referral to a radiation oncology center in St. Louis because of the rarity of my cancer, I chose to stay at home for my care. Since the Cancer Center opened in 2011, I've witnessed firsthand the dedication and expertise of the cancer care team. I knew I could trust them with my life.

I'm deeply grateful for the support I received and for the opportunity to continue working with such incredible co-workers. Our goal is to ensure that every patient has the resources and care they need to fight their battle with cancer, and your contributions to the Cancer Care Fund make this possible. Thank you for helping us make a difference in the lives of our patients and our community.
