Funds have purchased a **Chest Compression Device** for the Emergency Department to deliver life-saving care to cardiac arrest patients



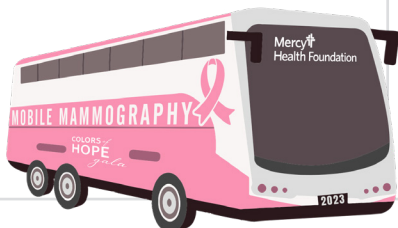
